“Light the Night” | Friday, Oct. 31 | 5pm-7pm

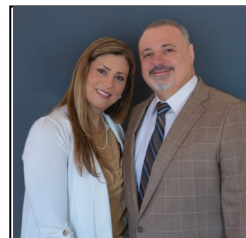
